1<sup>o</sup> That he is Albert-Frederick Daves, Farmer <sup>and</sup> Proprietor, of the Town of Lachine, in the District of Montreal, in the Province of Quebec, Canada, the universal Legatee <sup>and</sup> Devisee named, constituted <sup>and</sup> appointed in <sup>and</sup> by the Will <sup>and</sup> Testament of Dame Elizabeth Leishman, his mother, in her lifetime of the said Town of Lachine, Widow of the late James Bowley Daves, received and passed, at Lachine, on the fifteenth day of March eighteen hundred and ninety three, before M<sup>re</sup>. Leon Forest, the undersigned Notary <sup>and</sup> two witnesses, a copy whereof has been duly registered at the Registry-Office of the Counties of Hochelaga <sup>and</sup> Jacques-Cartier under N<sup>o</sup> 65,021, on the 30<sup>th</sup> December last - 1896. - <sup>and</sup> another copy whereof has been deposited in the Office of the Provincial Revenue Collector for the District of Montreal. 30<sup>th</sup> December 1896.

2<sup>o</sup> That the said Dame Elizabeth Leishman departed this life, at her domicile <sup>and</sup> residence, at Lachine, on the twenty second day of the month of December A. D. one thousand eight hundred

and ninety six, without having altered, changed or revoked her above mentioned Will - which is therefore her last Will and Testament.

3<sup>o</sup> That the Estate of the said Elizabeth Leishman is composed of several Moveables - consisting in household furniture, farming implements, horse and cattle, nineteen shares in the Capital Stock of the Merchants Bank of Canada, credits and Moneys in hand, the Collective Value of which amounts to a sum of Five Thousand five hundred and Eighty Three Dollars - \$5583.<sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> currency of Canada.

5° That the said Albert-Frederick Dawes has formally accepted the Legacy made in his favor by the above mentioned Testament of the said late Dame Elizabeth Leishman, his mother, by acts passed before the undersigned Notary on the twenty ninth day of December last-1896.- a copy whereof was duly registered at the Registry-Office of the Registration Division of the Counties of Hochelaga and Jacques-Cartier under N° 65022.

6° That Moreover the said Albert-Frederick Dawes, is quality of universal Legatee of his mother, the said late Elizabeth Leishman, is bound and obliged to pay to Miss Angelina-Martha Leishman, his aunt, Spinster, of the full age of majority, residing in the Town of Lachine, an annual rent of Three hundred Dollars during her life, said Rent being payable to her by quarterly instalments of Seventy five Dollars each, the first whereof shall become due and exigible on the twenty second day of January instant-1894- and thence every three months, according to the terms of the above mentioned Testament.

7° That in consequence of the premises, the said Albert-Frederick Dawes, is quality of universal Legatee of the said late Dame Elizabeth Leishman

Leishman, has received and taken possession of the whole of her Estate and succession, which consists in moveable effects as aforesaid, and which amounts to a net value of Three Thousand Six hundred and forty five Dollars and thirty Cents currency, after deducting from the Gross Value thereof a sum of nineteen hundred and thirty seven Dollars and seventy Cents = \$1937.<sup>70</sup> currency requisite to pay the Debts and Charges due by said Estate, as it appears from the detailed Statement of said charges, debts and liabilities hereinbefore given with the names, surnames, and residences or domiciles of the Creditors of said Estate, in conformity with the prescriptions of Chapter 17 of the Acts of the Legislature of the Province of Quebec 55-56 Victoria, as amended by Chapter 17 of the Acts of the said Legislature - 57 Victoria.

8° That the said Albert-Frederick Dawes hereby expressly reserves any right he may have to deduct from the Net Assets of the Estate and Succession of the said Dame Elizabeth Leishman, as hereinbefore established and declared another sum of money considered sufficient to enable him to serve the annual life Rent of Three hundred Dollars currency which he is obliged to pay to Miss Angeline-Martha Leishman, his aunt, in virtue of the Will of the said Dame Elizabeth Leishman.

And the said Mr. Albert-Frederick Dawes has required the said undersigned Notary to furnish a copy hereof to the Collector of the Provincial Revenue for the District of Montreal, as soon as convenient.
