And the said Parties have signed with and in presence of the said Notary, these presents having first been duly read according to law.

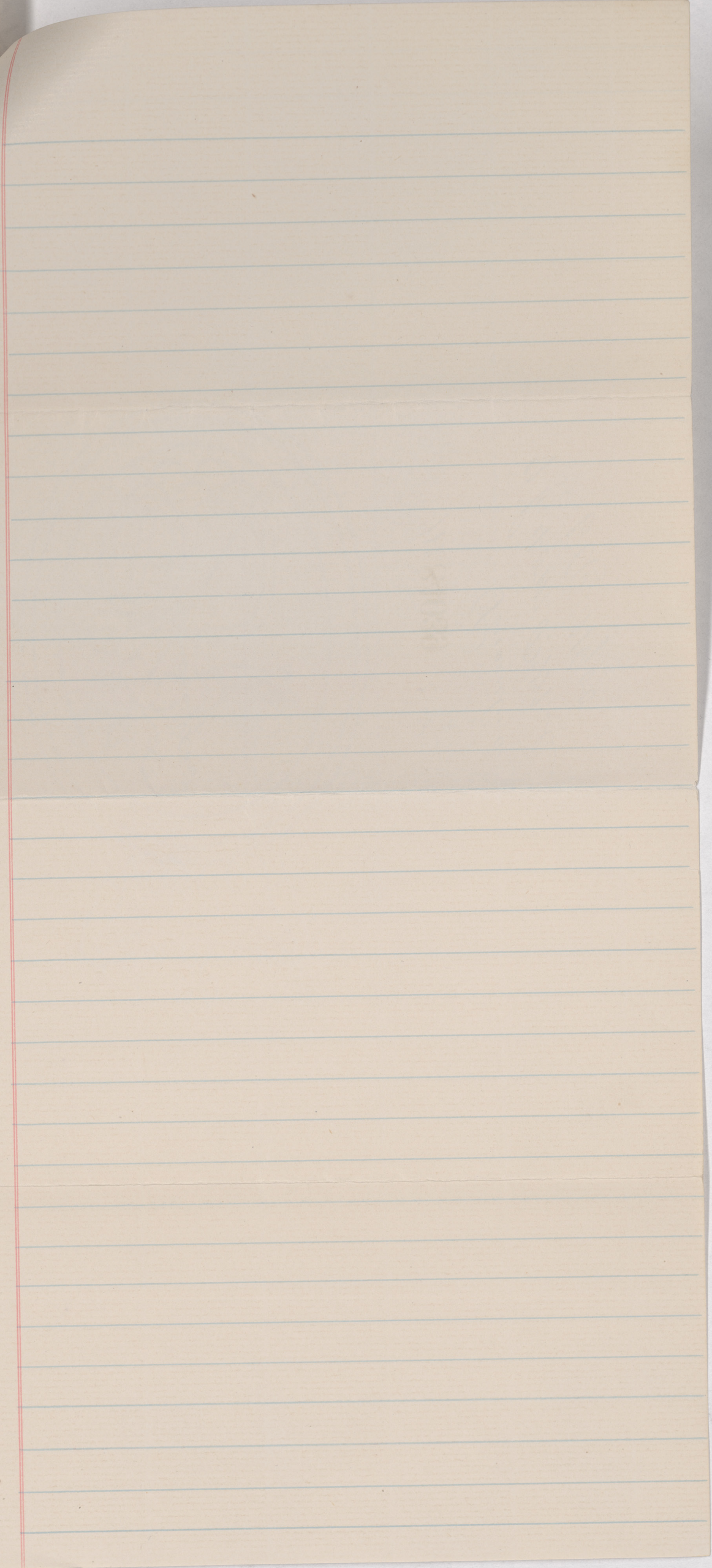
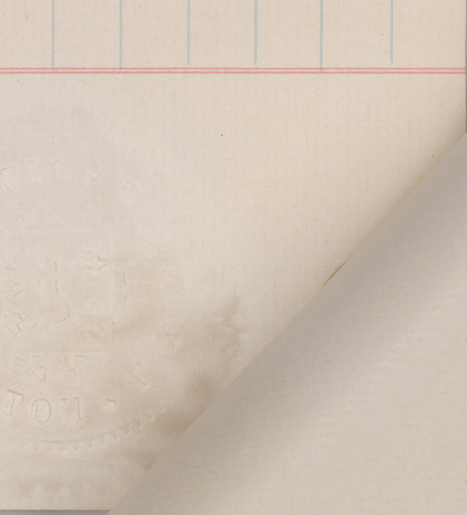
