> Articles of agreement entered into at the Grand Portage, between M'Savish, Frobisher & Be Nicholas Montour, Robert Grant, Patrick Small William MGelevrage Daniel Sutherland, John Gregory, Octer Pangmen & Alexander MKenzie for the purpose of carrying on a trade on their Soint accounts to that part of the Indian Country commonly called the North West or else where as the parties may hereefter agree, to be divided into twenty shares, of which M. Tavish Trobisher He are to hold six twentietts, Nicholas Montour two twentiettes, Robert Grant two twentiettes, Patrick Imale two twentietts, william M'Gillevray one twentiette, Daniel Sutherland One hventiette, John Gregory how twentieths, Peter Pangman two twentietts and Alexander MKerizie two hventietts in all profits and loss arising from thence, to commence with the first Outfit of the year 1792 and to continue thereafter for the full and compleat term of seven years.
