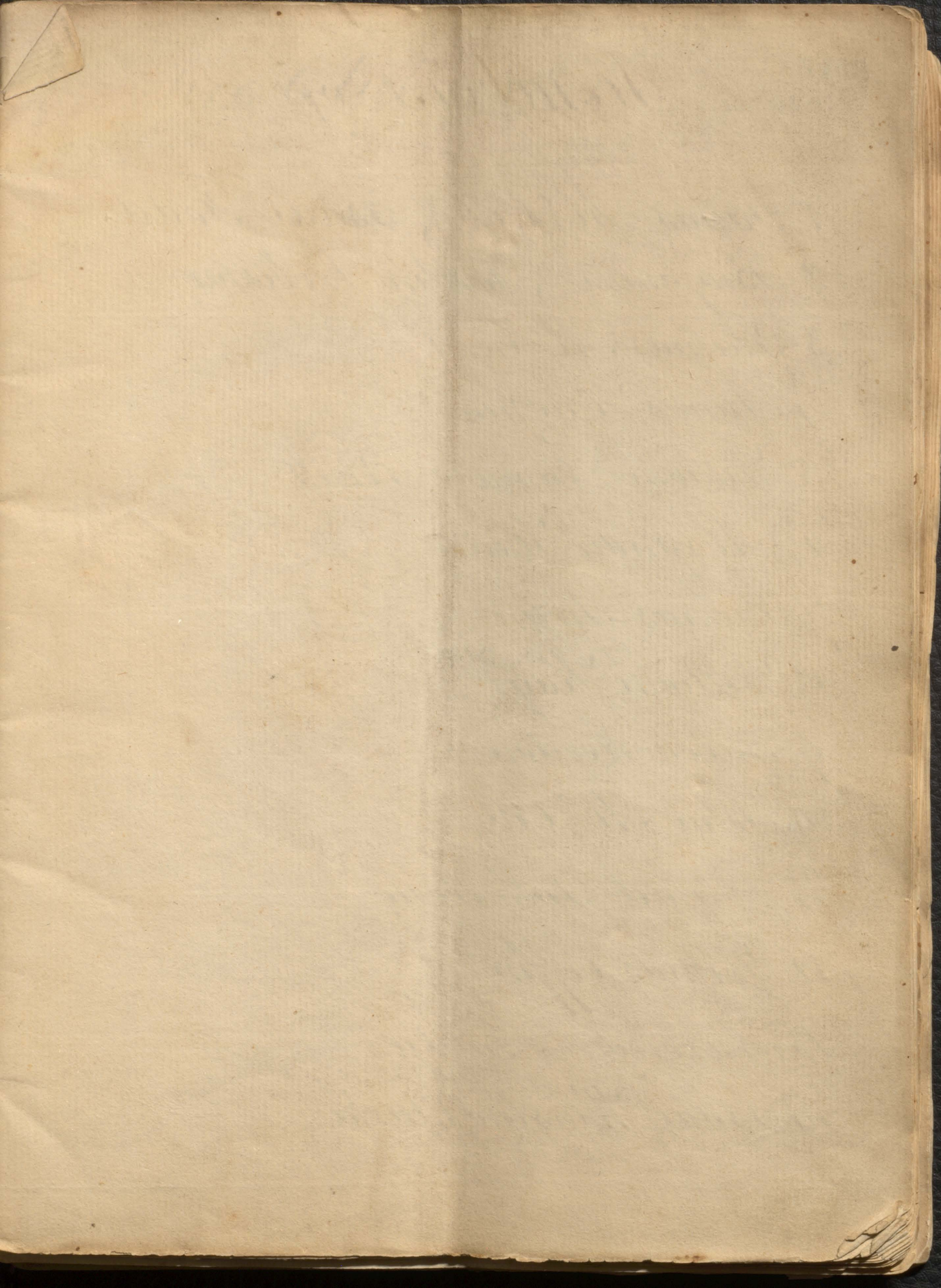

Fire Club No 1

2918

Considering the great Loss and Damage which happens to the Property of Individuals in case of Fire, for want of regulations for packing and moving Goods in Houses and Stores in danger.

We the Subscribers agree to form ourselves into a Fire Club for the mutual relief and assistance of each other, under the following regulations. *Viz.*

1. The Club shall not consist of more than Fourteen Members, and when any new Member is proposed it shall be done to the Stewards who shall notify the Members of it, on the back of their notifications for the Quarterly Meetings, such Members admittance shall be by a unanimous Vote of the Members present.
2. Each Member shall be provided with four good Leather Buckets and four Bags of a Yard wide and a Yard and half long mark'd

Fire Club N^os with his Name at length, to be kept at their dwelling Houses and not to be used either of them on any other occasion than Fires, on penalty for neglect of either or each Article five Shillings.

- 3 That a Steward be annually chosen for the collecting of fines and keeping an Account of the disposition of the same, which shall be rendered to the Company at their Quarterly Meetings; which shall be the first Monday Evening of the Months of January, April, July, and October to be held in such place and provided for in such manner as he shall think proper he notifying the Members previous to said Quarterly Meetings.
- 4 That a Deputy Steward be annually chosen to assist the Steward or to officiate in his absence or sickness.

5 The Steward or his Deputy (with any two of the Members at his desire shall once every Quarter, or oftener if he shall think necessary), inspect the Bags and Buckets of each Member, and if on such inspection they shall be found to be so much out of order as to be unfit for the service they are designed, or shall appear to have been otherwise made use of, each delinquent shall pay to the Steward a fine of Five Shillings.

6 Any Member neglecting or refusing to attend the Steward or his Deputy at their desire (after Twenty-four Hours notice) to visit the Bags and Buckets, shall pay a fine of Five Shillings, unless they can give a satisfactory reason to the Company. The visiting to be by the Members in the order they are in by these Articles.

7 Each Member shall acquaint himself with the Houses & Stores of all the Members of the Club and the different ways of access to them, and in case of Fire they shall repair as soon as may be possible, to the place most in danger, with their Bags and Buckets, and shall there distribute themselves in different parts of the Buildings so as to prevent Strangers from doing injury and shall, if it be thought necessary, by themselves and Assistants pack up the Goods and remove them to a place of security, and afford any other assistance in their power.

8 A Watch word shall be agreed on at the annual meetings for choosing a Steward (and entered in our Books) to be made use of by our Members at a Fire for the greater safety of the Effects of any Members that may ^{be} carrying away from Fires.

9. Any Member absenting himself from the Quarterly Meetings, if in Town, unless prevented by Sickness, shall pay a fine of Five Shillings.
10. Any Member absenting himself Four times successively from the Quarterly Meetings he shall be called upon by the Steward to know his reason, and if he declines being a Member any longer, the Company may choose another in his room.
11. Five Members being present shall be deem'd a quorum to transact the business of the Company; and is agreed that a major vote of the Members present be decisive.
12. In case of Loss of any Bags or Buckets belonging to any Members it shall be repaired by the Company; provided they take proper methods to have them found.

13 All Fines are to be applied to repairing any
Loss or damage sustained in Bags or Buckets
at Fires.

14 Each Member shall keep a fair Copy of
the Articles and produce them at each
Quarterly Meeting under penalty of
One Shilling.

It is to be remembered that M^r James
Mc Gill and M^r Benjamin Frobisher's Office
of Magistrate, not allowing of particular
attention from them to the Members of the
Club in case of Fire; their Partners are added
to supply their places.
