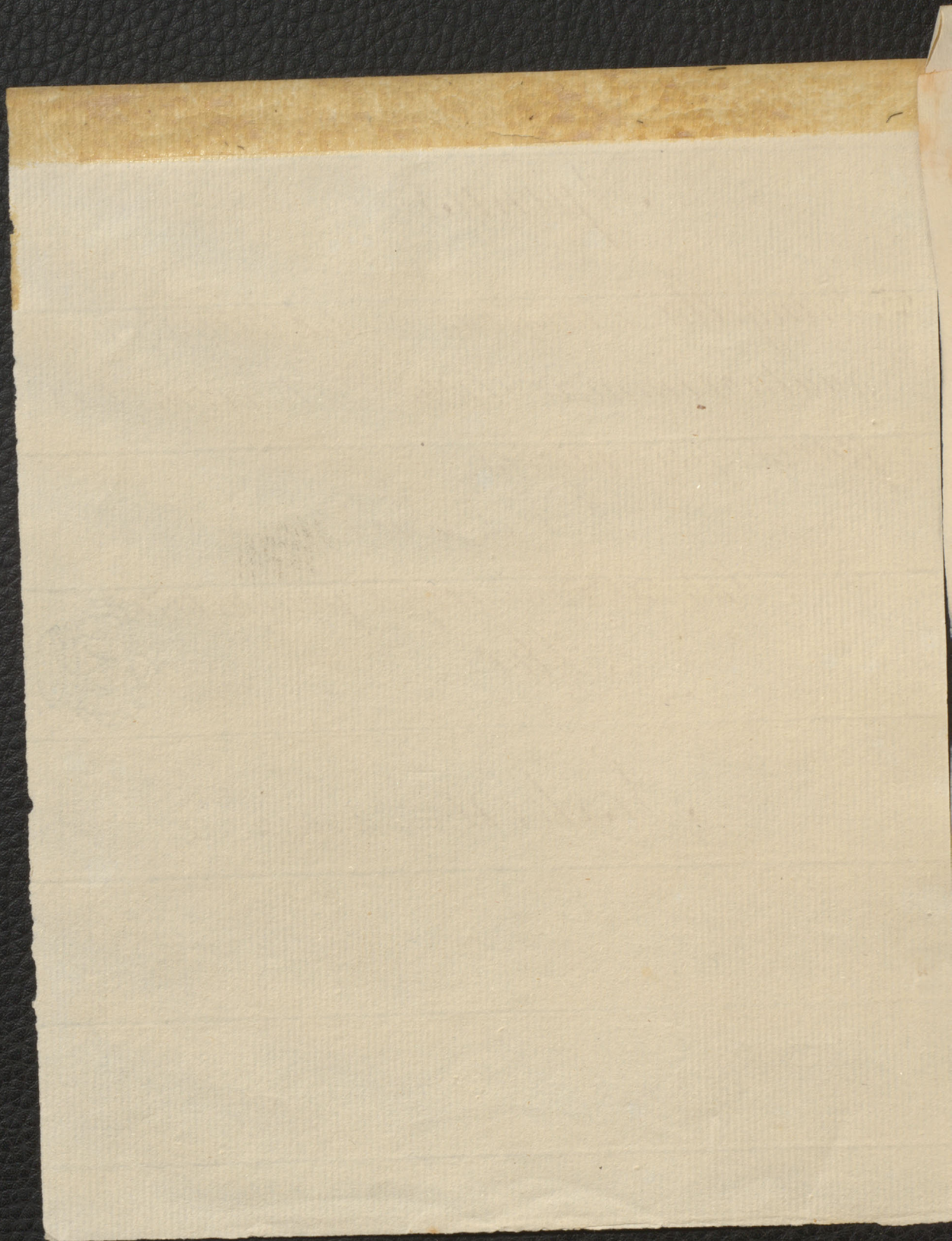

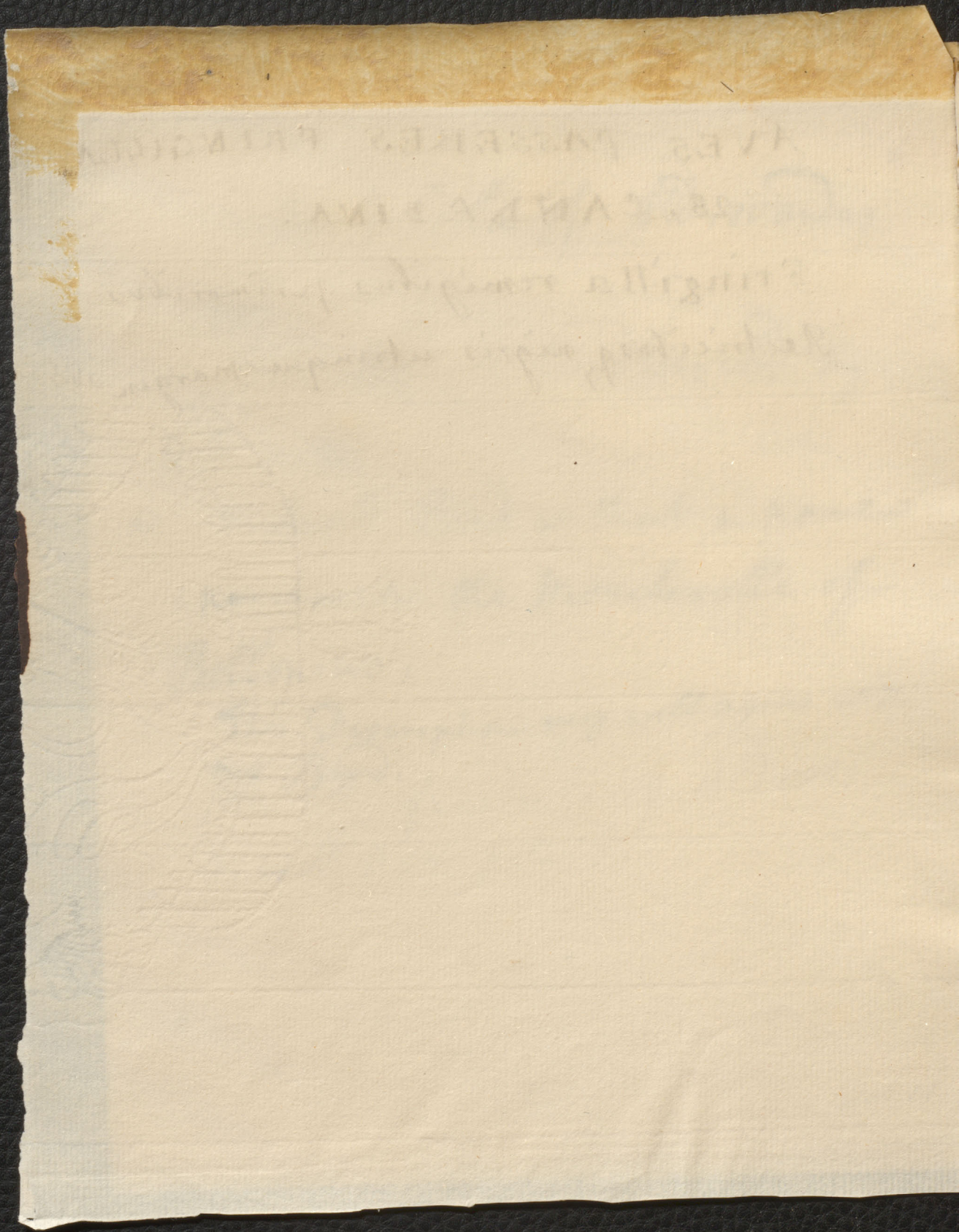

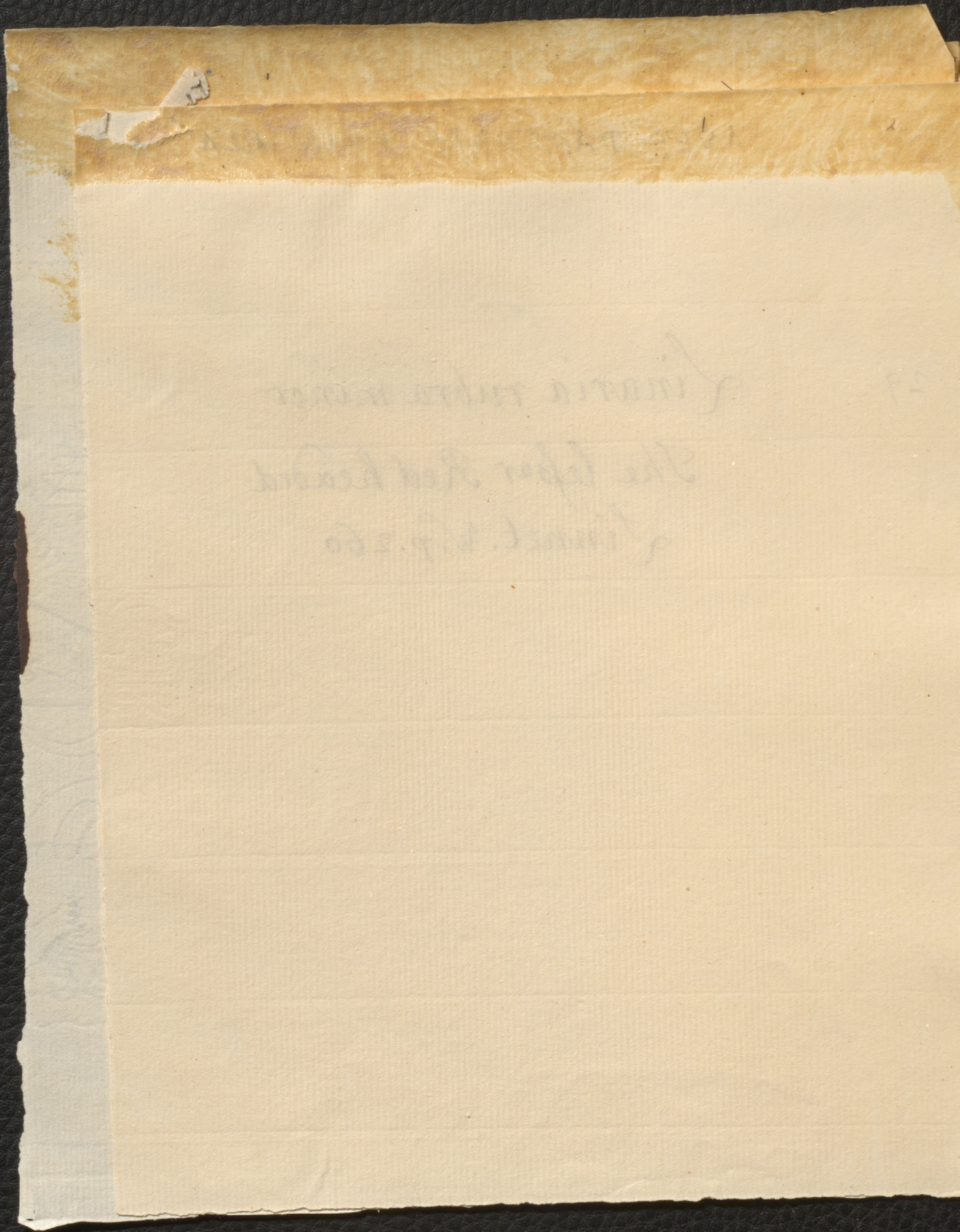

This was found by Mr. Jessop according to Willoughby, in the Peak of Derbyshire. It is twice as big as the lesser red headed Linnet. The colour of its head & Back is the same with that of the common Linnet, for the middle of both are black. but the outsides or edges of those on the Back red or the head cinereous. The middle parts of the Feathers on the Throat & Breast are also black but the edges whitish. Only the rump is of a fine scarlet or orange-tawny colour. the edges of the middle & quill feathers the Tail is 2 inches longer are white as

are also the tips of those of the 2<sup>d</sup> row.

The tail is 2 inches  $\frac{1}{2}$  long consisting of 12 feathers of which the 2 middle are all over Brown or of a Dusky colour, of the rest as well the outer as inner edges are white.

These white edges in the outmost part of Feathers are broader than in the rest.
