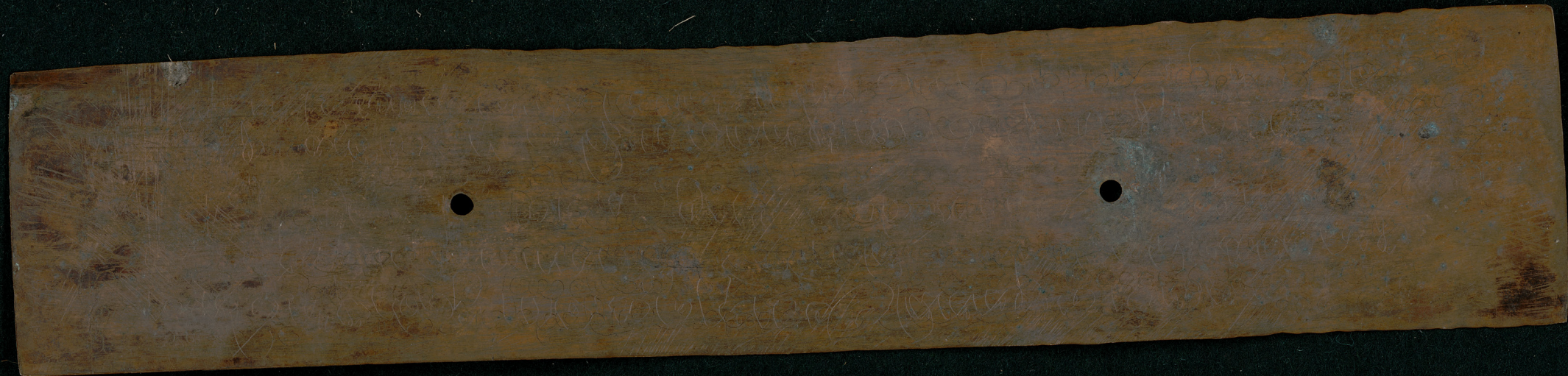


Single OLA, Written in Pali-Sinhalese on a
