That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the relatives of the fallen heroes of Westmount and to every other Westmount citizen who enlisted."

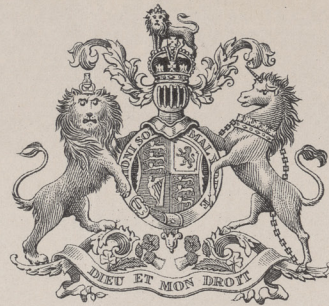
