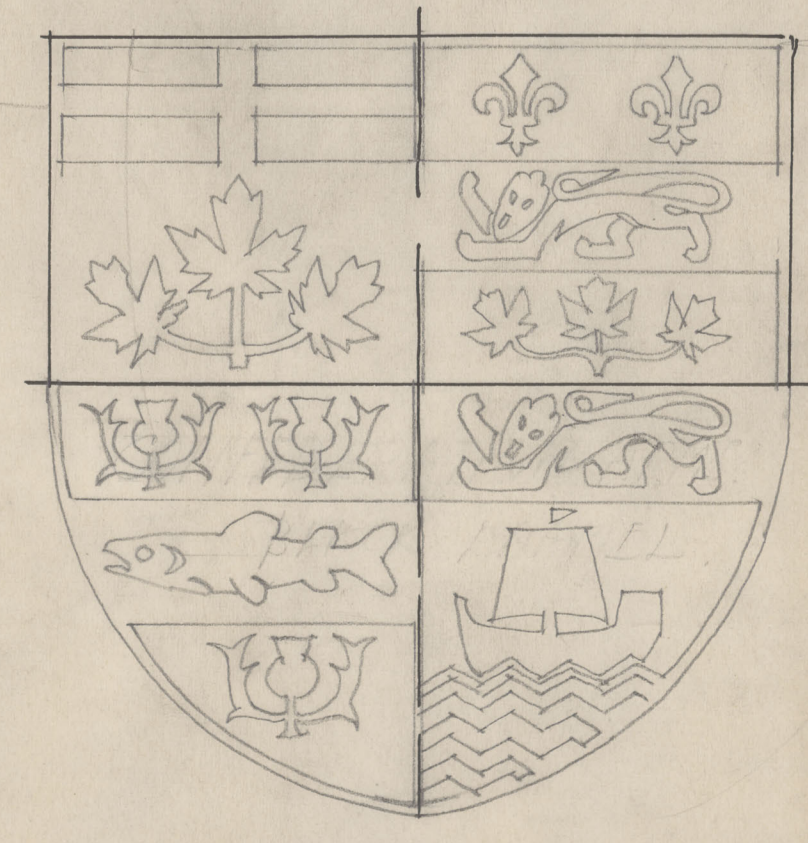


SACRED TO THE MEMORY OF

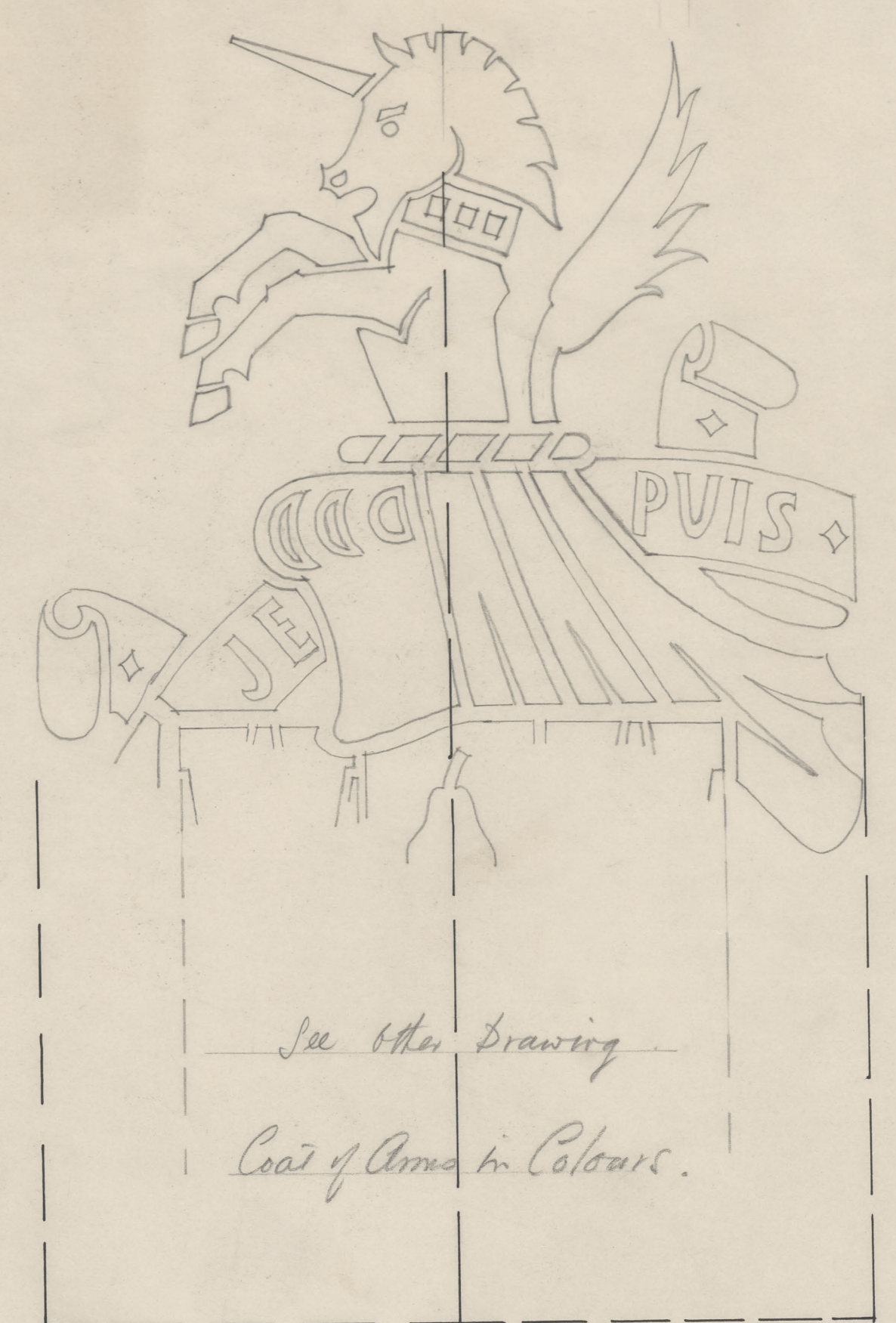

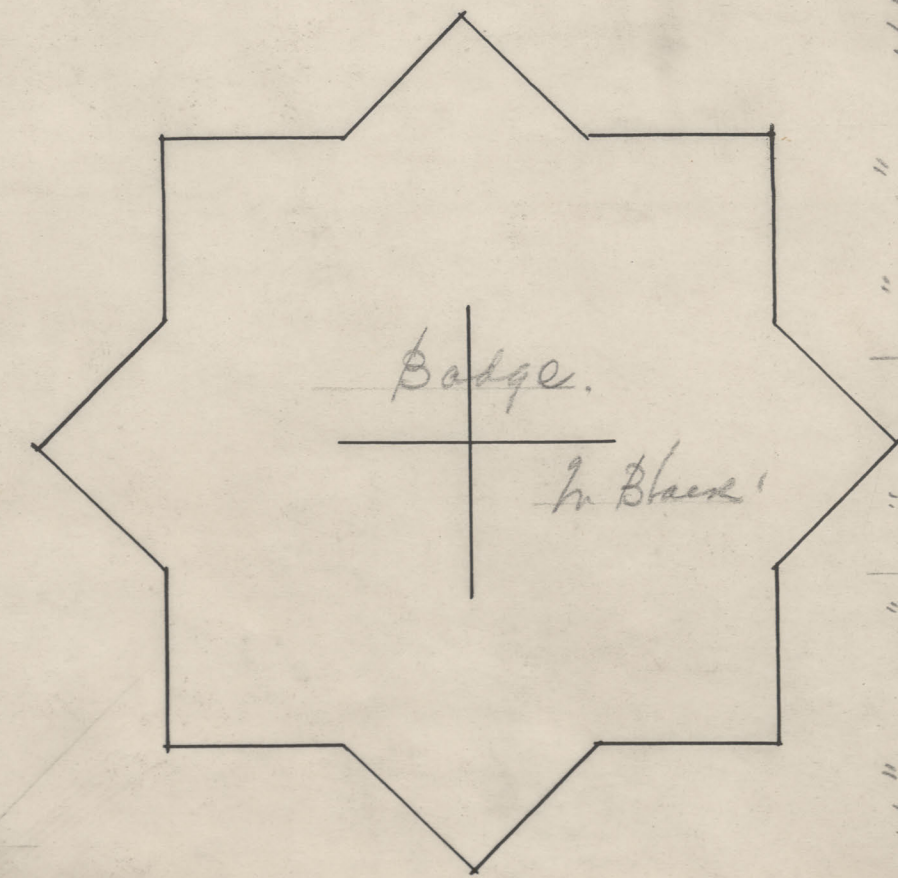

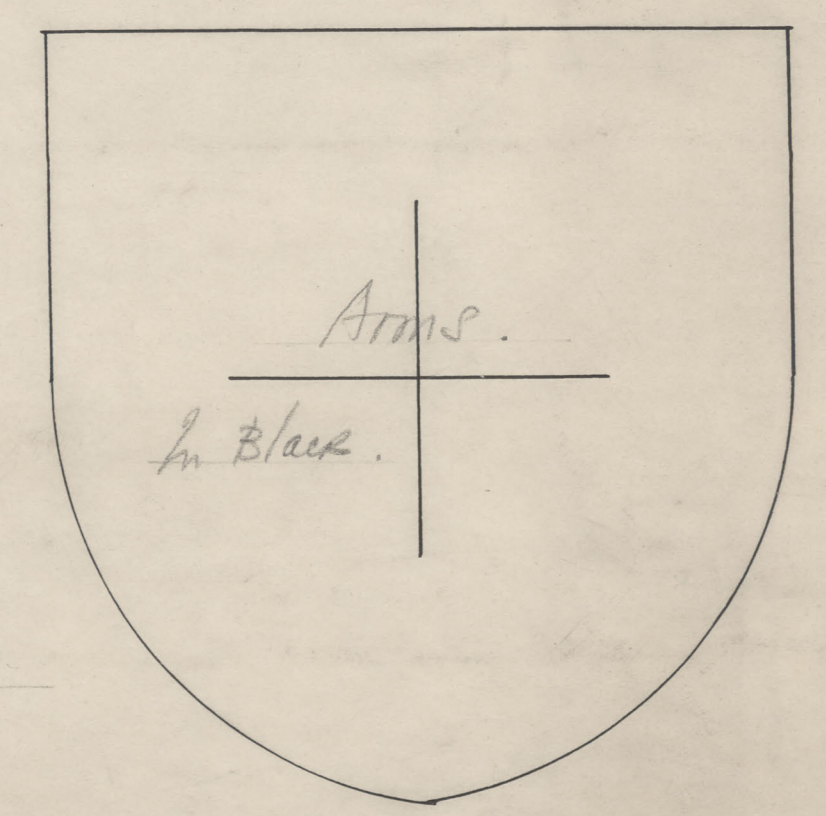

PRIME MINISTER OF CANADA

BORN IN 1821 IN THIS PARISH OF ST ANDREWS, THE ELDEST SON OF THE FOUNDER OF THIS CHURCH, THE REV. JOSEPH ABBOTT M.A. HE RAISED AND COMMANDED THE ARGENTEVIL RANGERS IN 1862 AND BECAME SOLICITOR GENERAL OF LOWER CANADA THAT YEAR, DEAN OF LAW AT MCGILL UNIVERSITY, AND LATER A GOVERNOR HE SAT FOR ARGENTEVIL IN THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY AND IN THE HOUSE OF COMMONS FOR TWENTY-THREE YEARS AND BECAME LEADER OF THE SENATE IN 1887 AND THE FIRST CANADIAN-BORN PRIME MINISTER OF THIS DOMINION IN 1891 AND DIED IN 1893
