out unto Eri Welton of Aylesford, Ezechiel Welton  
of Granville & Cephas Welton of Wilmot 1500 A<sup>cs</sup>.

Unto the said Ezechiel that tract or parcel of  
land marked N<sup>o</sup> 2 - on the annexed plan - containing  
500 A<sup>cs</sup>. Unto the said Eri Welton that certain  
tract or parcel of land marked N<sup>o</sup> 1 on the annexed  
plan - containing 500 A<sup>cs</sup>. Unto the said Cephas  
Welton that certain tract or parcel of land  
marked N<sup>o</sup> 3 on the annexed plan, containing  
500 A<sup>cs</sup>.

The tracts or parcels of land N<sup>os</sup> 1, 2, & 3,

marked E. W. Standing on the Western side a road  
leading from Diligent River to the Coal Mines
