

Know all men by these Presents that I James
Dawson Legally authorised agent for Lloyd hereby
make this Public Instrument of Vattel before
Mr Joseph Cormie and Mr Donald McDonald
of Prince Edward Island, that leaving of the
Lop of the Brig Joseph of Whiteham on the
River Islands and that a Quantity of the
Cargo of that Vessel was Landed at the
Magdalen Islands, prepared thither without
Loss of time for the Protection of the
Property in behalf of the Endormentary and
all concerned - that on my arrival here
I found that a Large Quantity of the Said
Goods had been Laid at the Harbour
of Nelson under the Direction of P. F.
Colbeck Esqr, that a Large Quantity of Said
Goods were also Landed ^{at the Harbour de Becc} and that I called
on the Parties in whose Possession they
were and demanded the restitution of
the Property, upon being paid Lawfull
Salvage for the Same, which Salvage I
offered in 3 Different ways viz. Bills
on Halifax or Pictou, Cash in Pictou
on carrying the property there on
out of the Goods themselves on the
Spot, there notwithstanding are

further Declare the Underwriters
thereon and also ~~that~~ ^{on} the Goods in Harbour
Le Beau (having been refused to be cleared
up) Exonerated from all Risk and Loss
arising from Said Sale, Damage or

on atherwise, and I further declare
that the Said P F Colbeck Esq and
Banawa Budmat, ^{Warrings Captain} and the other Salvors
are hereby held Responsible for the
said Property and all the Conse-
quences of Said Sale and refusal
of Comphyam with my requisition
I further declare that I have seen many
Parcels of Said Goods in the act of
being removed to Private houses and
forbid the Same. Δ
