Dear Sir
I have your favour enclosing two
communications from Taylor about the late land you
write me before about and after reading both
and seeing to some paper counts with Seneca
County I am led to believe W. Taylor has not paid
any money to W. Stewart on account of land the
letter signed by W. Dawson is written in 1838 and I
think that can have been no transfer to Taylor
or it would have appeared on a correct list of lands
set within the grant exchange between W. Stewart
and myself in 1838. Hence I know of no vacant
lots in the grant of c 100 acres with the improvements
valued at \$65. See as above told by some
person

whose name I do not now recollect that Laylor
had bought or intends to purchase a lot on the
River John Road this lot has since been sold to
a Mr McCarty and I do not think that Capt
have been any arrangement about it with
Whitcomb or I should have known it and I am
very of opinion Laylor has not made any
purchase or any payment as a confirmation
of this opinion you will find on reference to Mr Laylor
letter to his father in July 1833 he says he has purchased
and it appears from Mr Dawson letter to him Laylor
is the secret salary he was then anxious about
the deal and that he was prepared to pay the amount
purchase money. I enclose the two letters and
