Memorandum of agreement  
made on the twenty ninth day of  
August, 1842, between William  
Henderson of Pictou, Ship Carpenter,  
and James Dawson of Pictou a fore-  
said, bookbinder, of the other part, witness  
etc, that whereas the foresaid William  
Henderson hath this day, by and with  
the consent of the foresaid James Dawson,  
entered into possession of the vacant space  
between their respective buildings, on Water  
street, and which space at the front part  
belongs to the said James Dawson, now  
this memorandum witnesseth that the  
said William Henderson agrees to pay the  
said James Dawson the yearly rent of five  
shillings for the use of the said space, meas-  
uring three feet three inches between their  
said houses, for the purpose of erecting a  
platform and stair thereon, and for  
no other purpose; and the said William  
Henderson hereby binds himself, his heirs and  
executors and successors, to remove the said  
platform and stair, and quit possession  
of said space, at whatever time he or  
they shall be required to do so by the said  
James Dawson, his heirs ~~and~~ successors.
