North America Merchants my true and lawful  
Attorneys and attorney jointly and severally for me  
and in my name or in the name of my said  
firm or otherwise and for my use to ask demand  
sue for recover and receive of and from Robert  
Hutton late of Liverpool aforesaid Shipbuilder but  
now resident or sojourning at Pictou aforesaid or  
elsewhere in Nova Scotia aforesaid or New Brunswick  
All and every the sum and sums of money debts  
and demands whatsoever which now are due and  
owing unto me the said Roderick McLeod by or  
from the said Robert Hutton under or by virtue of  
the Bill of Exchange hereunto annexed dated  
at Liverpool aforesaid the Twentieth day of June  
One thousand eight hundred and forty four drawn  
by me under and by the style of my said firm  
of "R. McLeod & Co" upon and accepted by the said  
Robert Hutton for the sum of One hundred and  
fourteen Pounds, ten shillings and six pence payable  
six months after the date thereof including as well

This is the letter of attorney aforesaid to me the  
sealbreaker of Thomas Bay Cameron made  
before me on the third day of January 1865.

the principal money mentioned in the said Bill, as  
the interest commission and all other charges and  
expenses which shall have, or may become due thereon  
or that shall have or may be incurred by the non-  
payment thereof. And in default of payment or  
thereof to have use take commence and prosecute all  
lawful ways remedies actions suits and means in my  
name or in the name of my said firm or otherwise  
for the recovery thereof by attachment arrest or other  
legal process and to compound or agree for the same and  
give time or indulgence for payment thereof and in the  
mean time to accept such security for payment thereof  
as they or he shall think proper. And on receipt of the  
said sum or sums of money or of any part thereof or  
acquittances or other sufficient discharges for the same  
for me and in my name or in the name of my said  
firm to make sign seal and deliver and generally to  
do all other lawful acts and things whatsoever or  
concerning the premises as fully in every respect as I  
myself might or could do if personally present. And  
also from time to time in their or his discretion one  
or more attorney or attorneys under them or him for  
the purposes aforesaid to substitute and appoint and  
again at their or his pleasure to displace or remove  
therby ratifying and confirming all and whatsoever  
my said attorney or attorney shall lawfully do or cause  
to be done in and about the premises by virtue of these  
presents. **In witness** whereof I have hereunto set  
my hand and seal at Liverpool aforesaid this third day  
of January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight  
hundred and forty five
