Dickson & Co. in your favor for which please to accept of our best thanks; also order for Stationery to which we have given our best attention & now have the pleasure of handing you Invoice of the same as annexed, and Bill of Lading. The goods were shipped per the Beido Graham Master for Picton sailed 18th inst. We trust to safe arrival & opening to your entire satisfaction.

The diaries rec^d have come to hand & are at your credit. We are sorry to observe your remarks about the Illustrated Bibles: Previous being 14th Bibles have been out of print for little less than a year & will not probably be reprinted; as not a Copy was to be had we thought it most advisable to send you the nearest approximation to it that could be got. We hope they may not lay long with you; the book had a very extensive sale in this country.

The Thermometers you remark are not to order. We don't keep this article in stock & had accordingly to purchase them expressly for you. We saw the party from whom they were purchased, lately; he recommends to get the figures reprinted please to charge us with any little expense that may be incurred.

Maephus folio Bible will be ready shortly. Please say in your next if you still wish the 3 Copies sent. They will cost you 20 each. We do not give them for less to the trade. We are in receipt of your favor of the 5th inst. The order is in hands & will be dispatched by a vessel expected to leave shortly from this port direct.

James & Morrow Liverpool have remitted us three pounds & 6. which sum is at your credit. out of the proceeds of the draft rec^d 21. March/31 we have paid Messrs. Thumson & Sons Fifty one pounds 5/10 Stg. We enclose discharged ac^t for the same.

With regard to Discount we beg to refer you to our letter of the 17th April. The price of rags has still continued to rise & there seems no probability of a decline for a considerable period notwithstanding we have claimed no advances on paper books printed books &c. consequently our profits are very much cut down & leave us no margin for extra discount. Be assured we will do the best we possibly can for you.
