Gentlemen -

I received yours by Post intimating the arrival of the two Books. Since you have been so attentive to my order I will take them both, provided you receive in exchange for some other book of equal value, the English copy should not prove a strict translation of the Greek one - There is a Boat going from this place to Pecton in the course of three weeks by which you will receive 9/- being the price of the Books together with the postage of this letter - Should the Boat fail to go about that time, the money shall be sent by Post.
