To Mr Jas Dawson

Dear Sir

These Periodicals have
come since my Father's death in his name
& allowed it to continue on so to the end of the
year but expected when I continued them in my
name My Father's would be stop'd but last week the
ones I ordered came and my Father's also so that I
have 3 copies of some and 2 copies of all the periodicals
If you are writing home will you be kind enough to
state how the matter stands and stop any more coming
in my Father's name I wrote home at the time of my
Father's death to a cousin of mine and requested him
to write me and to ^{have} his death noticed in some of the papers
but I suspect the letter has never reached as I have never
heard from him
