Your favours were duly received and with reference to your account I made a positive agreement with your Mr. W. Dawson for six months on which terms I can buy from Messrs. W. & S. Kinlays & Co. Gossip & W. Grant of Halifax with interest after six months but it is a little more convenient to get from Picton - however if it does not suit you to sell on such time I must order from Halifax as I have to wait one year for the most of my sales - but at the present time all trade is so completely suspended and will be until the Spring trade opens that it is very difficult to collect any ready money - I now enclose to you a five pound bank note which please place to my credit and as soon as I can will send you on more - you may send me half a dozen each of Carpenters Spellings Munnays ditto and Dawsons Geography by next coach if on the above named terms - I some time past requested A. S. Macdonald Esq. to say to you that I wished to stop taking the family friend any longer as I find it too expensive for me but if we continue to have business together it is most likely I shall be able to work off a considerable amount of your stock this year
