Dear Sir

I have just received  
the package of Importers notes  
3 Dives 2 of them not of the  
kind you sent me before  
but an old antiquated form  
which is not satisfactory to  
me particularly as that kind  
of Decottet rightly used to be  
sent 2/6 per Dive. But  
the Summons, you sent  
we are utterly worthless  
having been wholly superseded

Some 7 years ago by the New Practice Act  
and I had 3 or 4 Dives  
or have them ~~the~~ which I have yet  
being wholly worthless to me or to  
any one else I am a little  
surprised at this Injust Confes  
particularly after the ~~and~~ manner  
in which I pointed out the Error  
in your case against yourselves

I shall therefore  
expect you to forward me on  
at least 2 Dives of Summons  
under the new practice act  
free of expense at an early day  
and shall return the 2 Dives  
of old ones sent or to be them

to await your orders as you may  
direct. In fact the 3 Inveros  
& I have one of precisely the  
same form and any one may  
have them for as long as they trust  
you have made an accidental mistake only  
I await its correction & will be
