CIRCULAR.

At a meeting of the Committee appointed to carry out resolutions having reference to the establishing of a Bank in this City, to be called

THE UNION BANK OF HALIFAX,

It was resolved to call a meeting of the Subscribers to the Capital Stock, to be held at Mason Hall, on Tuesday, 6th May, at 2 o'clock, and to submit, for the information of the Subscribers, the Act of Incorporation, passed at the last session of the Legislature, with a report of the proceedings of the Committee.

And it was further resolved, that a circular be addressed to Subscribers, not residing in Halifax, intimating that a portion of the required number of shares are undisposed of, and that they be solicited to increase their interest, and that they use their influence with individuals in their neighbourhood, and, as far as they may feel warranted, prevail on them to take Stock in the proposed Bank.
