

Letter  
to Mr Honeyman  
May 1856

Dear Sir

I beg to enclose £10. Please  
acknowledge the receipt of it & let  
me know how much more I can  
do I cannot lay down on your  
account. I will send the balance  
of Mr. Osborn's - Have had a  
good many very generous donations in the  
Month of Nov. 18. But it is impos-  
sible to calculate. That my  
conjecture <sup>may</sup> ~~was~~ no more than I  
am in the world & that there is every  
reason to believe that it will be paid  
although it does not come up very  
quickly - Our Bible Society has  
been disconnected from the Halifax  
Society - This year's subscription  
which will amount to £20 or about  
it is to be devoted to the Circulation  
of the Scriptures among the allied armies  
in the East - We have also contributed £2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>  
to the Waldenry - when you write to Mr. Osborn
