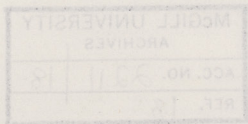


Letters  
Capt To Bayfield  
to Acty 1858



Charlottetown, P. E. Island  
6<sup>th</sup> October, 1856.

My dear Sir

Pray accept my sincere  
Thanks for your kind note of the  
24<sup>th</sup> ult. — We are expecting every  
Mail a Tutor from Scotland,  
having written for one last Spring.

But should we ever again  
determine to send our boys  
from home; we should be glad  
to avail ourselves of your

compensate us for the absence  
of our boys, it would be the
