I have received your last parcel of Books, containing Hies Vol 3. and Heugstuber's Christology Vol 2. with the 14th or July (1856) No of the Ev. Review

There is missing yet the 15th No. of this Review. This No. was published in Jan. '56 and commences a vol.

If you have forwarded I am sorry it should have been lost. I have made some enquiry in Ch. Town about it, but cannot find any intell^gence of it. I am disposed to think if the work has come to you that it must still be in your possession and my reason for thinking so is simply

this, that you would have put it
up with the parcel you have
sent me along with the
one you have forwarded
at the time you forwarded
the 16th no. you did not
send the 15th for you say
in a note that you had only
one at hand. My calculation
goes on the supposition that you
received the 15th & 16th nos. together
as they have been long published
& most likely to come out at
once, but of course of this
I cannot be sure. And if
you are sure that you
have forwarded since I saw
you nos. 15, 16, 17. then it
must be so. only I have

not as yet received the 15th and
your invoice will inform you
if these three have been forwarded
to you. this summer. Probably you
will let me know shortly if I
can get the No. some way or
other. for I suppose it would be
better to reorder one than to break
the set.
