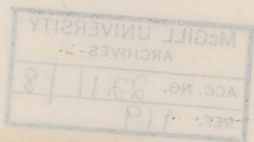


Letter  
of Hazard  
Dated 1857



Charlottetown  
Oct 8th 1856

Dear Sir

I received your enclosing order on Mr Reddin, which we presented and he promised to pay in a few days, no doubt we will get it during this month.

We are getting on with the Porrooniceen, we should have had them done by this time but my binding hand has been sick for six weeks, and school books being in great demand we had enough to do to supply them. Our Government undertook to supply the school books, imported from the Society in Ireland



but by the negligence of the  
Secy Bd of Education they got  
none for the last year, so that  
it caused us good sale for  
ours.

Have you ordered your  
seeds yet, and could you  
get a small supply for  
me.

We want a dozen Maps and  
1/2 doz Hand Book of Nova  
Scotia. Could you also get  
me a Nautical Almanack  
for 1857 by next week or  
any publication having the  
Sun's declination for 1857
