

Extract of a Letter from
Jas Dewsary to G A Halsted
Esq Secretary at Delays,
dated, 24 Decr, 1856.

"It will not do, how-
ever, to leave Rictou without
an agent, as it is decidedly
the best Harbour, in the Lower
part of the Gulf of St Lawrence
and will always be resort-
ed to by vessels in Distress &
Needing Repairing. Permit
me therefore to recommend
to you as my Successors here,
Mess^{rs} Jas Primrose & Son,
