July 14th 1837

Dear Sir I have the Harmonicon
counted up and nearly finished
but can make only 323
complete. If I print 36 of
sheet "five" I can complete that
many more and with 7, 9, I
could make up over 100. If
you wish I will put the plates
again on the Press and complete
them, likely if the odd sheets
of the last ed were collected
many might be completed.

I am afraid I cannot
remit you any money until
autumn. Strong has just failed
to take up his note at the Bank
and I have been obliged to do
it, and the Bank have not been
discounting lately.

I shall have to take
possession of his things
next week, Would your
successors be likely to
require a set of Binding
tools to set up a Bindery
for Plain work, Please ask
them and let me know

They say we are to have
a steamer soon if so
I may take a run over
