Dear Sir,

Two years having now elapsed since the date of our first & only transaction with Mr. Chas. S. Sterns of Truro, we beg in accordance with your letter of Guarantee to intimate that Mr. Sterns still owes us, as at 30<sup>th</sup> June last, the sum of £77. 7/-.

In December we received from him a remittance of £40 & we have no reason to doubt that he will by & by be able to pay us in full, but in the meantime we consider it necessary to apprise you of the state of matters.
