Respected Sir

It is again my
pleasent duty to acknowledge the
Sum of 20/ handed to me by Mr
Norman Reddy on the 6th Inst being
your handsome donation in behalf
of the poor in Victou I esteem
it an honor, that you continue
to think me worthy of distributing
it and a prooff that you are
pleas'd with the disposing of it.
As in former years I have limited
your Charity chiefly to old People
this Season, already 10 individuals
have been cheer'd by your bounty
Some of them in the extrem feeble
ness of old age I dont always
give it in Money, In some cases
I do to assist in getting fuel
but in others I purchase very little
Necessery I think they are most in

on want of according to their res-
pective circumstances fear of
the receipts of your generosity
last year viz "Sally Wilmat"
"Maryjane Hedley" "John Buff" and
"John Besters Spence" have all
died, In all probability a number
of those who have been putakers
this year, will be called away
I often feel sorry that I cannot
give the name of the donor
in a number of cases the sums
are small and many of them
are so dull of hearing that it
would be difficult to make them
understand. But I am very
sure that I may in their name
return your heartfelt thanks
and best wishes that you may
be spared and rewarded
