My dear Sir,

Your favor of yesterday duly came to hand - with respect to the articles you expect by return of steamer be assured I will see that they are properly handled and forwarded immediately. I believe there is no duty on goods from the provinces we have had no freight for up trips as yet so cannot say whether the custom House has any duties to charge or not, in any case I will attend to the matter according to your instructions.

The "Queen Victoria" is the next steamer expected from Pictou and Capt Davison (who accompanied Capt Pouliot) is on board, and will pay same attention to your goods as if on board of "Lady Head".

The steamer Lady Head will sail for Pictou on 14th instant and will be advertised as usual, as you intend sending your son down you would do well to secure a berth next week early.
