Dear Sir

We have today taken down all your old papers and books, which we have packed into one large box, also a book which we got from Mr Primrose to enclose.

There is also another small box containing Mr. Bonpian's papers which would not go in the ~~large~~ <sup>large</sup> box, but as it is properly addressed, and the cover well secured we think it will arrive safe.

The boxes we will ship in the Steamer "Lady Head" she has not yet arrived but is expected tomorrow, as we do not know any person in Quebec to consign them we you had better appoint an agent in Quebec to look after them on their arrival.
