Dear Sir

Annexed we give you statement of acc from the beginning of July 1852 when you first acted as Agent for our Magazines in Nova Scotia. You will see that in addition to the £2.9.0 allowed in 1854 for Magazines which had been ordered to mistake by you we have made a further allowance of £1.11.9 as above, in consideration of your loss of several parties not paying their subscriptions. The whole affair is a loss to us, but for the influence the Magazines have in Nova Scotia the Agents here would not be at the expense of sending out copies at all.

We trust that on examining you will find the statement correct, as we have very pains to make it so, and with kind regards to yourself at this the close of our transactions with you
