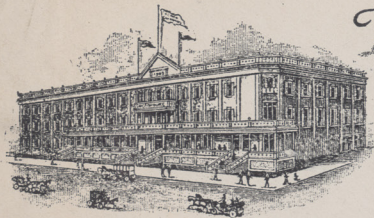
I'm going in to tea now and have a lot of reports for after dinner so this may be all for tonight.
