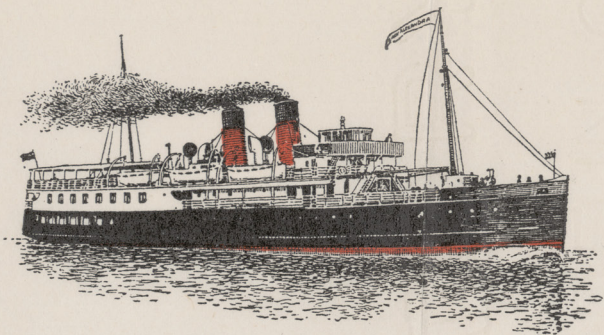
My dearest Lois
