Ryan —



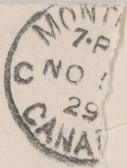
