The pioneer, John Harrington Sr., came to Canada about 1802 with a company of enterprising New Englanders who built the first paper mill in Canada at St. Andrews in 1803-1804. (See Bouchette's Topographical Dictionary, 1832.) John Harrington's second son, William, married Laura Seymour and was the father of Dr. Bernard Harrington and Miss Laura Harrington... I think the book you refer to must be my father's "Memories of Old St. Andrews."

Please give our cordial regards to your sister, Miss Clare Harrington. My sister and I remember meeting her on several occasions.
