

SUBJECT / OBJET Identification of North American Boundary Commission Photos.

The basic information on the attached list of titles was taken from the official caption list which accompanied the set of photos submitted to the Foreign Office and now located in the Public Record Office. Copies of this list and the photos are found in our accession 1958-206.

Supplementary information, found in the square brackets, was derived from research in the Boundary Commission papers in FO 5, from the letters of Samuel Anderson, and from the captions which appeared on the reverse or underneath the photos.

The dates assigned to the photos are not precise except in a few cases where the date was verified by outside sources. The most notable case of this occurs with the photos of the dead Crow Indians where the date of July 31 is given by both Millman and Dawson. The group of photos taken at the North West Angle is given as October since it was during that month that both Commissioners travelled to the Angle and they are in many of the photos. October seems to have been the first month that the Royal Engineers commenced work at the Angle but they continued until early the next year. Therefore, some of the photos taken there may be in November and December. The dates given in brackets are as close as can be determined and are based on written accounts of the movements of the survey teams.

The official FO list is deficient in many points. We have photos which do not appear on the list or in the FO photos. In some cases the photos differ (eg. #85) or are cropped so differently that they are difficult to identify (eg. #32). I was unable to discover the true number of the photo I have numbered 256.

Where the FO caption list misspelled place names I have left the spelling as it appeared.
