

Outstanding Record By Salmon Arm Cow

The registered Jersey, Adrina's Owl's Buttercup—30409—bred and owned by Bernard Harrington of Salmon Arm, B. C., has qualified for a Canadian Jersey Cattle Club gold medal certificate.

Starting on test at 7 years and 4 months, she, in 365 days yielded 15,005 pounds milk and 736 pounds fat on twice-a-day milking. Buttercup was sired of the silver medal bull, Adrina's Owl—19556—a son of the silver medal bull, Owl Interest Count—13970—formerly owned by A. H. Street of Chilliwack. Her dam, Duke's Buttercup of C. D.—20702—bred by Mrs. Craster of Vernon, B. C., was an untested Calf Club cow who is also the dam of the silver medal cow, Duchess Owl Interest—43994. She started test February 2, 1932, and calved after test on April 4, 1933.
