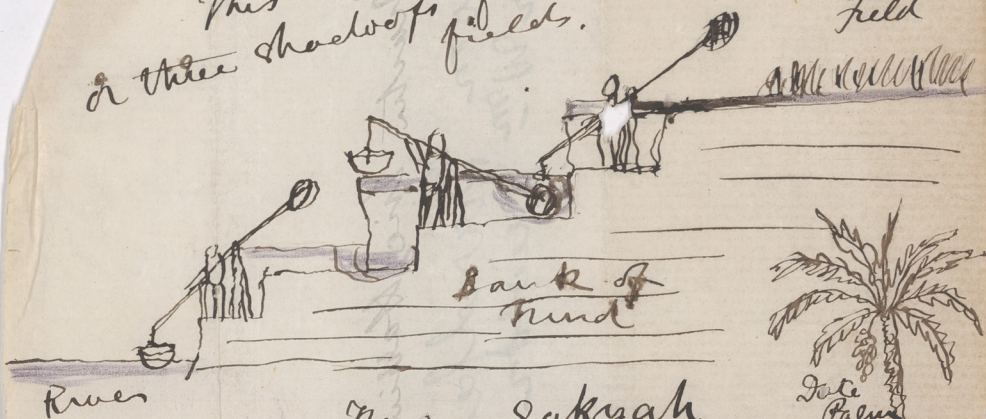
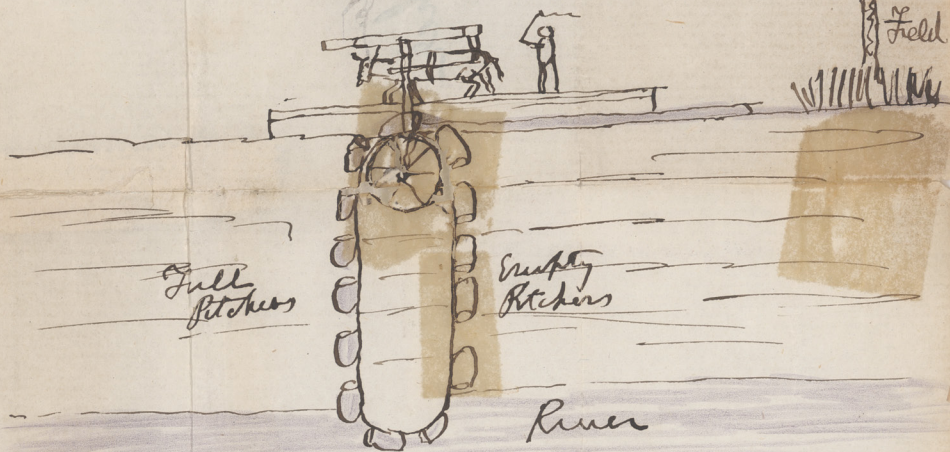


This is a shadoof
