ary Conference, at Toronto, which

assemblies of our time - Fourty
over 4000 men, from all parts
of the dominion, spending four
or five days in discussing

nation & deciding to do it in
this generation - & arranging
that Canada's share of money be
1,500,000 for Home Missions &
over 3 million for Foreign - I don't
know how many men they are
sending - They say there are
hundreds amongst the students
willing & anxious to go -

any way - The world is dying
for lack of faith & God's spirit
is calling to the people who are
willing to hear - You can
