

Boston Sept 12, 1846

My Dear Sir

I sent you by Friday coach a rough draft of my report, which I hope you have received. Yesterday morning received the plan from Knox, and send by to-morrow's mail a more perfect copy of the report to Mr A. S. Archibald, who will forward it to you on your return from Boston. In the meantime the copy you have will serve to give you any information necessary in Halifax or the U States, and when you receive the other you can return it to Knox or here.

The second copy is accompanied by a large plan of the lots, and more accurate details of the appearances on each of them, it is also more carefully written.

In your copy, Rev P. C. Leaver's name is omitted and the distances between the diggings are not quite accurate, otherwise it is all right, so far as facts
