

Boston 4th Decr 1849.

Dear Sir, I was quite taken by surprise
when I heard only a few days ago that
Dr. Waddell's business which took him
away so suddenly and unexpectedly was
a subscription office in the Lincolnton Building
at Carlleton opposite St. John's S. Church
Boston. I have just seen a telegraphic des-
patch as follows

Blanchard has consented to act as agent
for Ben Presley, or at least all of them

Mr Samuel Pollock, and all should be in
closed in one paper directed to the
