Missions boat which has been contributed by the children  
of this congregation. The small remaining sum you may  
credit me with towards the payment of the commentary  
which you sent me per Mr Grant. I would have trans-  
mitted the whole amount but had not Ava tested  
currency suitable for transmission in a letter. Would you  
have the goodness to acknowledge the receipt of the boat  
money in the Chronicle.
