My dear Sir,

I am happy to inform you that the packages for your Missionaries in the New Hebrides, advised by your obliging favor of the 4th Ultimo, have been safely delivered at this port, and have been reshipped on board a vessel to Sydney to the care of Dr. Ross, who will I doubt not transmit them to the Islands by the first opportunity.

Immediately on the receipt of your former communication, I ordered the 5 Cases for £50, and though I had heard of the loss of the "Thomas Henry", it was not until the arrival of the Captain in

London, that I learned the goods were safe.
The "Medora" arrived the day after your
letter, so that it was not necessary to
make a fresh insurance.

I have insured the goods to
the Island via Lyancy
