We wrote to you on 2nd inst and have since received your favour of the 27th February.

We immediately put the map in Mr. Legass' hands, but he says there is so much work upon it that he has found it impossible to send you a proof to-day, but he will have it ready to go by the next mail.

We send you a few patterns of cloth: please return what you select or inform us of the ^{neg.} in regard to stamping in gold on the side the cut Fig. 33. we find that it would require to be cut in brass specially for the purpose: a cast from the woodcut would not stamp nor would the brass block print; — on account of the shading, &c. The lowest cost to you would be 10/- for the die, and one halfpenny each extra for stamping in gold. Please say if you wish it so done.

We think the work should be announced shortly before publication, as nearly ready; but we think you would require to expend from £10 to £15 for advertising before and after publication to do the book justice.

We have received the MS. from Messrs Webster, but neither Messrs Johnson nor Nelson have called to look at it. We shall enclose it in the care
