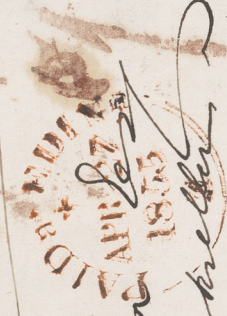
We have received your letter of 10th curt with instructions regarding the boarding, &c. which will be carefully attended to.
