We have now the pleasure of sending you particulars regarding the printing and publication of the supplementary chapters to "Acadian Geology."

1. We enclose statement of accounts sales of the original work, showing a balance due of £2.4.1. In our former letter we had mentioned the remaining stock to be 9 instead of 12 copies, the actual No.

2. We enclose our account connected with the Supplementary chapters, for printing, paper, woodcuts, and doing up, &c amounting to £25.3.6½ which after deducting the above named sum of £2.4.1 leaves a net balance due us of £22.19.5½

3. We send a statement of the mode in which the copies of the original work and Supplement have been disposed of, in compliance with your instructions, including copies ^{Sup^r} to Editors and 5 copies to British Museum and privileged Libraries in Oxford, Cambridge, Dublin, and Edinburgh as per act of Parliament.

the price of Supplement as retailing at 2/- and of Work
and Supplement 12/0. This is charging the additional

your approbation.
