My dear Darwin

I have your letter of the 23rd
Dec. It will not be possible to
send you a proof of your paper.
The Secretary of the Geological is
straining every nerve to get all
the papers into the number of the
Journal which is to come
out in February; and then
would not be time to receive
the proof of yours back again.
I have seen a proof of mine
& Hunt; but your & Carpenter

are not get out of the painter's hands. Yours will be submitted to Carpenter, who will be requested to see that you & he do not in any way disagree.

The Duke of Argyll has been taking an interest in Exoon. He mentioned it in his address to the Royal Society of Edinburgh on entering for the President's chair.

I met him at the Museum in Crayke Street & while he was examining the specimens there he ~~saw~~ remarked that they reminded him of some of the Tyne marbles. I sent him

a copy of the paper that had
 been communicated to the
 Geological, to propose him
 in regard to what he was to
 say at Edinburgh. He wrote
 to me afterwards that he was
 gratified to find the resemblance
 the Tyne Marble had
 struck him & particularly
 that you had in it
 discovered traces of the
 structure.
