My dear Dr Dawson

this rock I have colored its distribution
in those parts with which
you will have to do.

I have taken advantage of Mr
Paley's map to slightly change
the line of the new Brunswick Coal
field. Had I Robt line before, but
I suppose Mr Paley being after him is
supposed to be a little more accurate.
To show clearly the boundary of the

Upper & Lower Carboniferous in
red. The other lines you will
know from the distribution

you have given me.
