Dear Mr Dawson

You will see by
the Record that I have published
your letter some on the Montreal
Inq. to Labrador. I wished that
I might lay it before the Board (as
when the Board resolved to lay
the whole matter before the Church
they wished your letter published

I had no time to write for
permission but it was of such a
Character that I thought I might
do it without an express permit.

The want of men was an
effectual bar to doing anything
decided in the matter just now
but we do not expect to be always
so straitened. I have therefore
written to Mr Taylor asking

of those now in Labrador Male and
Female are likely to remain and if a
change in the directorship is likely
lead to their withdrawal. —

We have notified Mr Taylor
that we will lay information on
the subject before our people but
that we do not wish them to wait
on us. I have asked them to
make proposals to other Evangelical
Churches that we will be happy
if they succeed in getting some
body to undertake the work. but
we do not refuse. The sentiment
and feeling of our people may
surprise as to warrant our
undertaking it. For the present we
simply give information on the
subject and interest the people
in it which is desirable, whereas
at all our & direct it
