My dear sir,

Your diploma
seems very suitable;
but I cannot see what
part I can take in
the examinations, or how
I can sign the Diploma.
As Principal I can sign
our University Diplomas
and as Professor I am
not aware that I have
had any part in

The education of the
young men.

My impression is
that the Diploma should
be signed by the Pres
of the Board, by the
actual examiners in
Veterinary art and
by the Professors and
other actual instructors,
unless the institutions were
affiliated to the University
and in some sense under
the supervision of its

Cooperation I do not
think that I could
sign the diploma. It
is a question however whether
this might not be
done, so as to make
the diploma a permanent
one as in Edinburgh,
and to give my & the
rest of the Board a
seat in the Corporation
as representatives of the
School. In the mean-
