Gaspe Basin  
May 26<sup>th</sup> 1894.

My dear Sir,

I cannot hear of anything in the shape of lodgings likely to suit you. except the hotel at the Basin. Mr Wilson has ceased to carry on the hotel and it has reverted to Mr Coffin whom I will request to write to you immediately letting you know what accommodations he can provide -

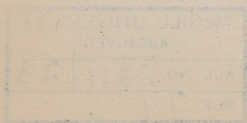
